The province of New Brunswick Department of Education has the responsibility for public education from kindergarten through grade 12. The public education system is divided into 9 Anglophone school districts and 5 Francophone school districts .

District 08 is an Anglophone District situated in the southern part of New Brunswick. There are 36 schools within School District 08. The student enrolment is approximately 12,500. Schools are designated as Kindergarten to grade 5; Kindergarten to grade 8, or Grade 6 to Grade 8. High Schools which include grade 9 to grade 12.

School District 8 offers a wide range of programs including an Integrated Special Education System, Early French Immersion and Intermediate French Immersion, a wide variety of enrichment activities and Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate Programs. All our schools are connected to the internet and technology is integrated into learning and administration. Our schools also have a rich tradition in athletics with teams competing in sports such as hockey, basketball, soccer, football, rugby, swimming, volleyball, baseball and track and field.

Procedure for Enrolment in Schools in School District 08:

- Request information about application process as an International Student (Student Visa) from your Embassy.
- Request conditional letter of acceptance for study as an International Student, from School District 08.
- Support completed application for International Student Status. With a conditional letter of acceptance from School District 08 to your Embassy.
- Upon approval of International Student Status from Immigration and Employment Canada. A fee of \$8431.00 for a full year or \$4216.00 for one semester will be required annually. (This fee is subject to change from year to year)
